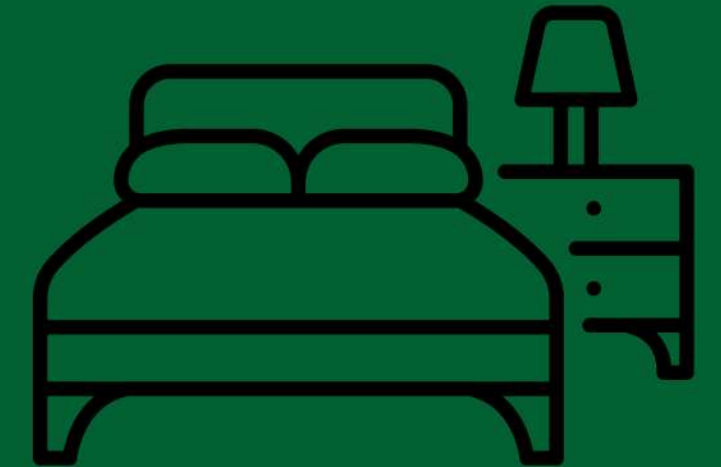

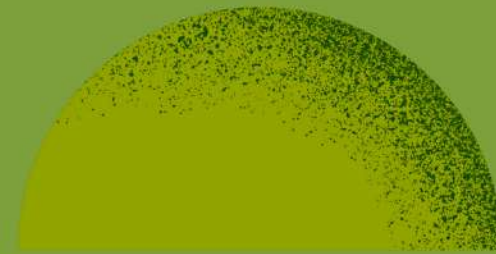


OUR MISSION

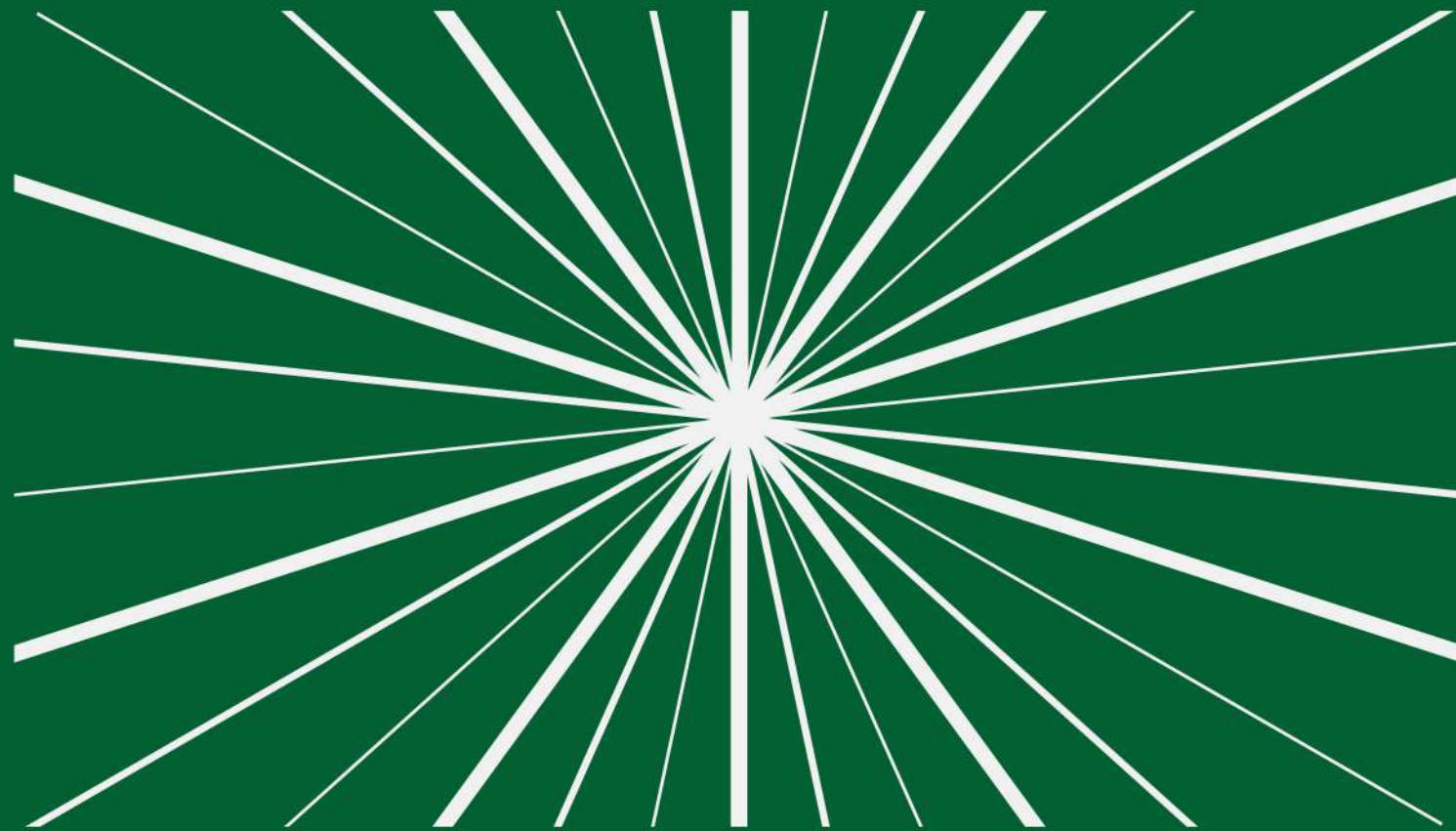

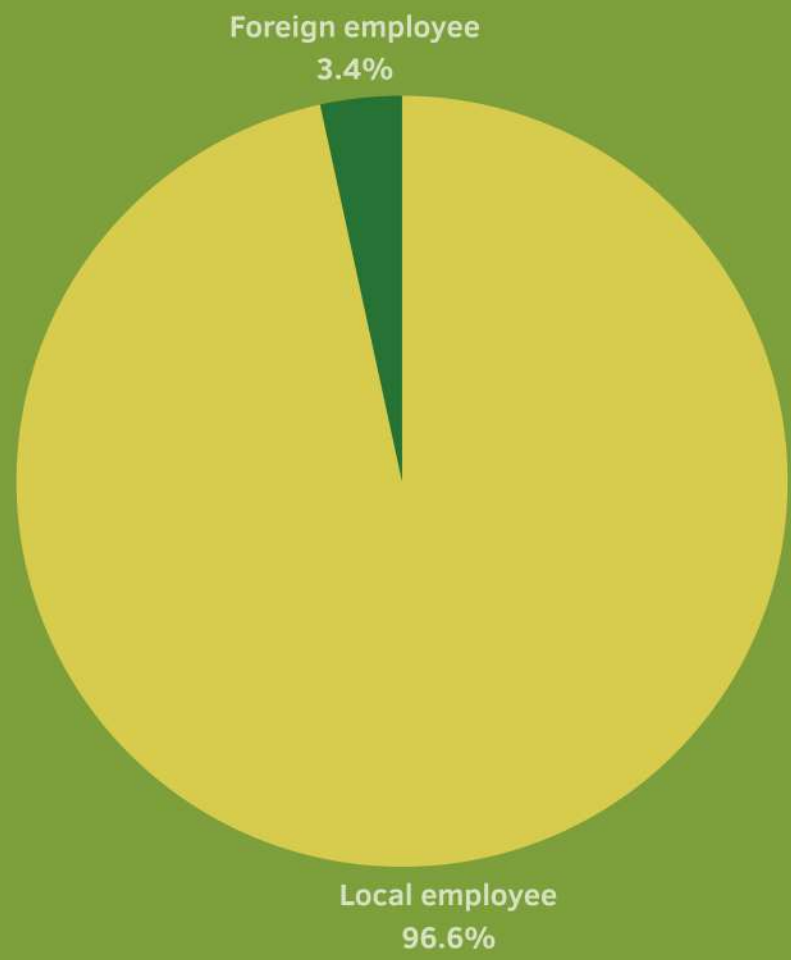
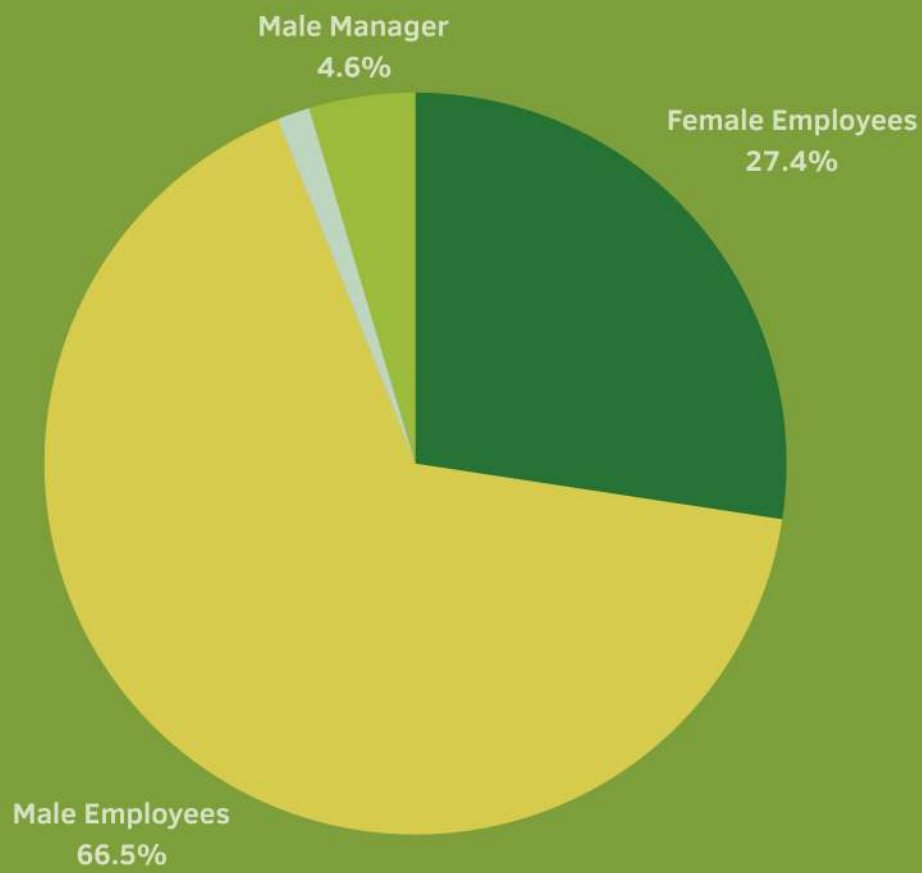
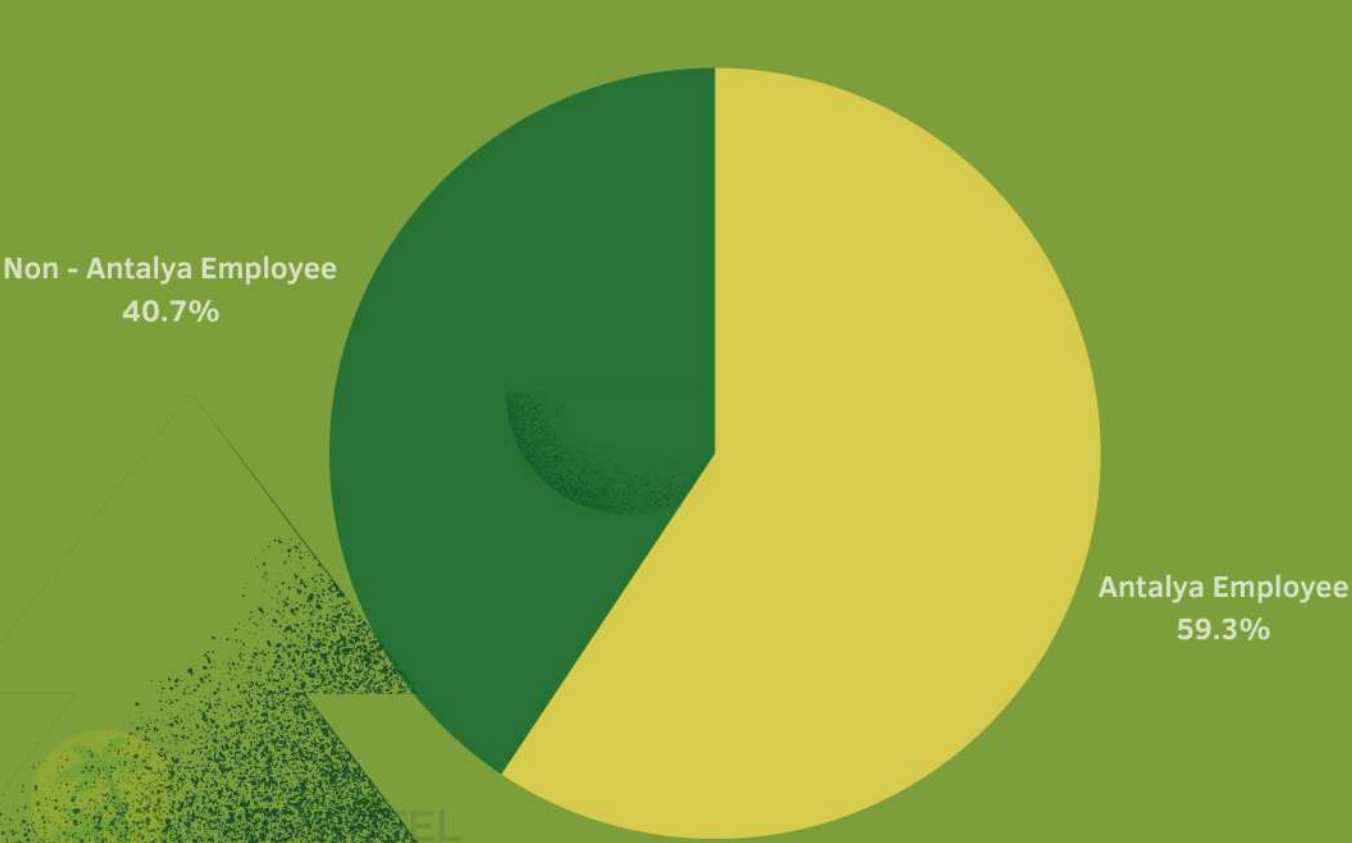
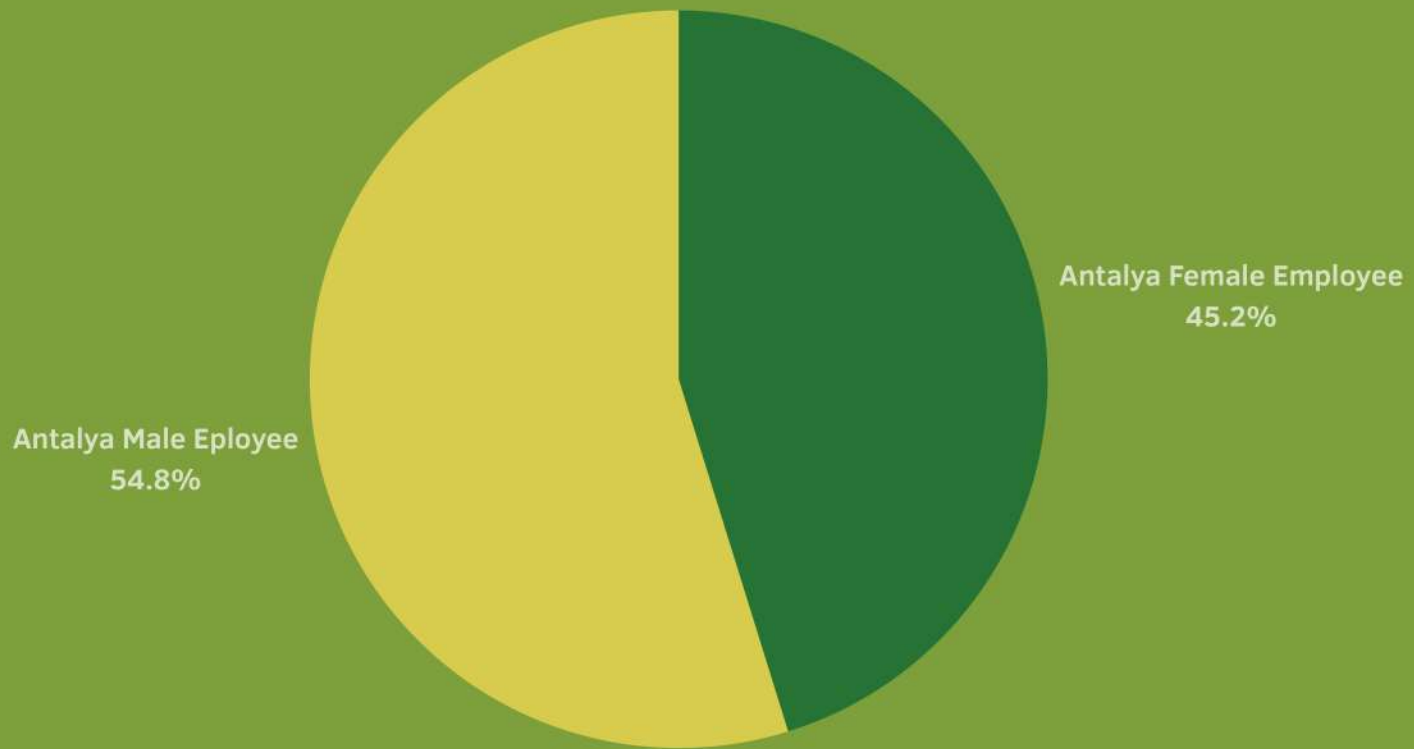
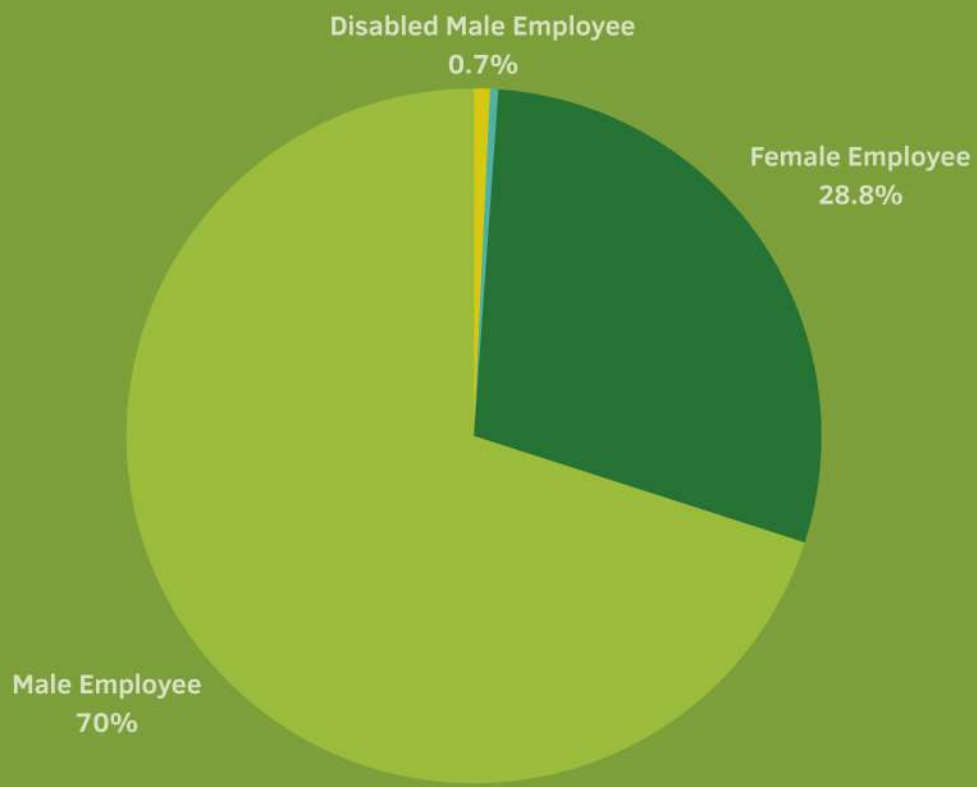


WORKING LIFE AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

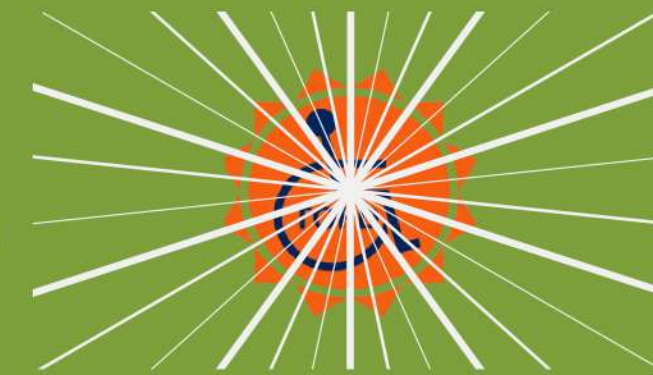
SOCIAL AWARENESS

SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENTAL APPROACHES

OUR SUSTAINABLE FOREST PROJECT WTH SEED BALLS

Club Hotel Sidelya managers collaborated with students from Çolaklı/Manavgat Primary School to instill sustainable environmental awareness and contribute to afforestation efforts. Participants exchanged ancestral seeds during the Forest Week event, in partnership with the Ata Seeds Exchange Association, the Turkish Foresters Association, and the Forest Management Directorate. This initiative supports local biodiversity and ensures sustainable provision of rich and healthy food for future generations, while also preserving cultural heritage and traditional agricultural practices.



OLIVE HARVEST FESTIVAL

On World Food Day, we celebrated by harvesting olives that represent the characteristics of the Mediterranean climate grown at our facility. The harvested olives were given to our guests, and the olive oil produced was offered at our buffet. Through this initiative, our facility highlighted the importance of sustainable environment and food on World Food Day, while also drawing attention to the region's characteristic product."

Manavgat is in danger of extinction due to intense tourism and recreational use in limited areas of the dunes (as well as fire-burning and vehicle crossings on the beach). Our facility is aware of the importance of sand lilies in biodiversity and has protected them.

As a result of our attempt to attract beneficial insects, we built an insect house designed from recycling. In this way, we aim to biologically fight against invasive species by creating a habitat for them and increasing the rate of beneficial insects in the population. 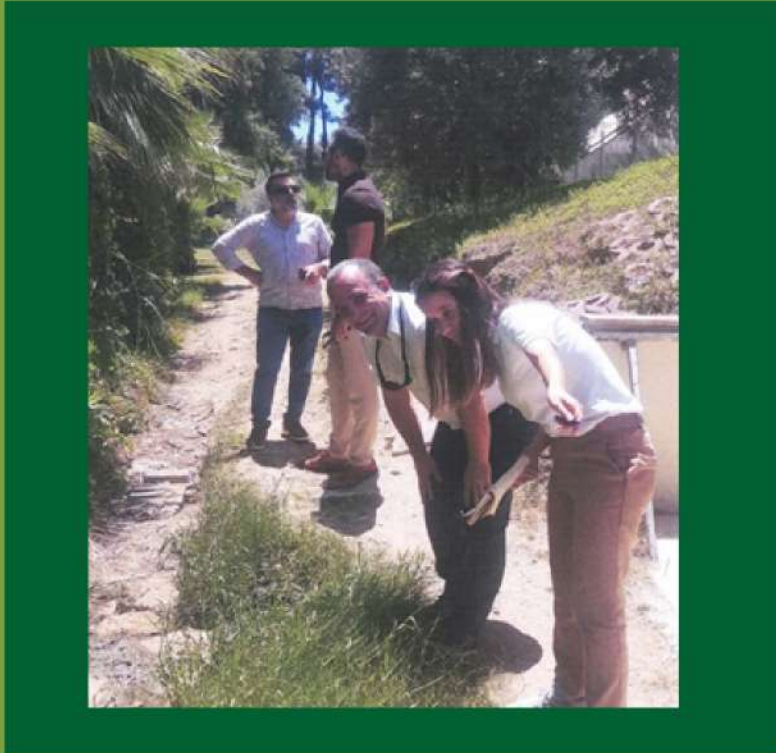
THE BIO GARDEN

Club Hotel Sidelya is aware of the importance of working today to leave a sustainable environment and nature for future generations. Conscious of our role in resource utilization, our facility integrates eggshells and organic waste into the soil of its garden, where organic products are grown and served to guests. Additionally, we have begun establishing the BIO-GARDEN, which consists of heirloom seeds, aiming to reduce carbon footprint.

WASTE AND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

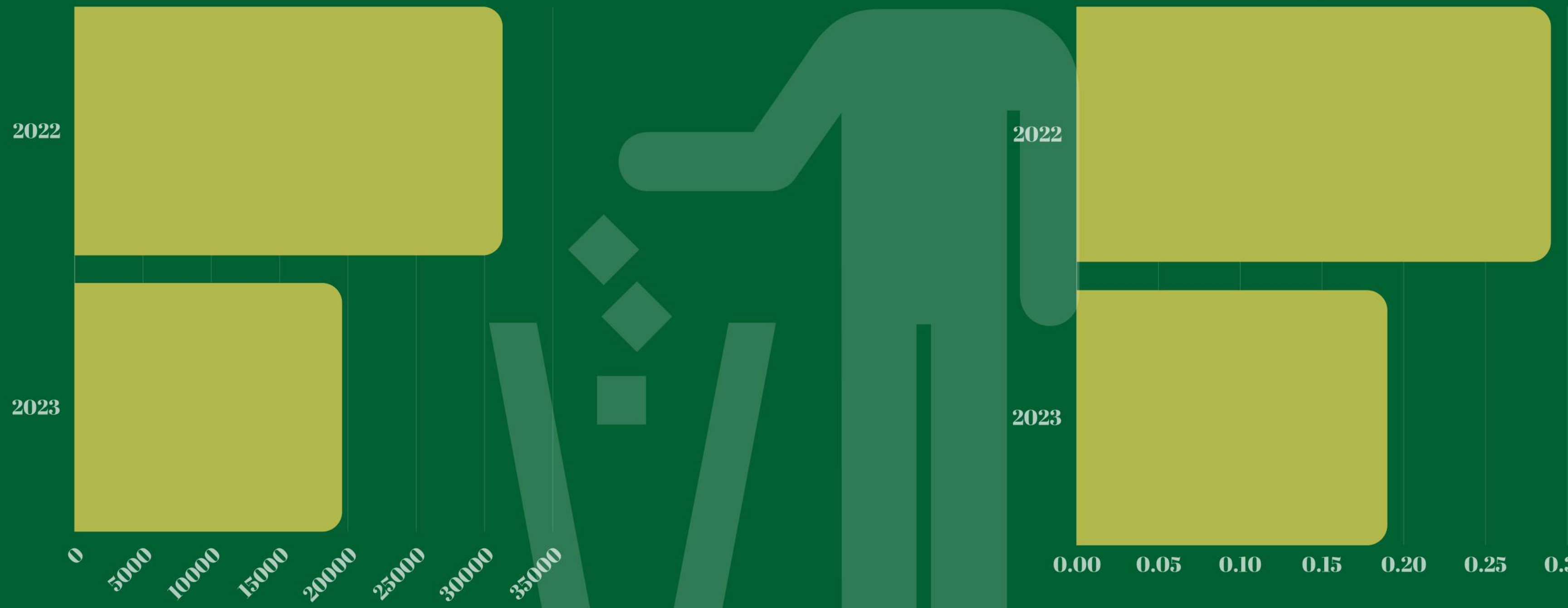
- Under the framework of environmental legislation, we collaborate with environmental engineers to receive consultancy services and training support. At our facility, packaging waste, hazardous waste, organic waste, construction and garden waste, medical waste, used oils, and batteries are collected separately. They are stored in designated temporary storage areas within the hotel premises in compliance with regulations and then collected by licensed companies. These materials are subsequently sent to sorting and recycling facilities for proper disposal.
- We aim to minimize the use of single-use products in food consumption and opt for bulk packaging whenever possible.
- We aim to minimize the use of single-use metal cans and plastic bottles.
- We strive to use renewable energy sources for our energy consumption and invest in this area.
- We water our gardens in the late evening and early morning hours to prevent water loss due to evaporation.
- Throughout the hotel, climate-adapted plants that prevent invasive species are being planted.
- We offer bicycle rentals to our guests to help reduce carbon emissions and support education with the proceeds.
- There are practices in place to reduce plastic (packaging) consumption in the buffets, for example, jam, honey, etc.
- At our facility, we collect pine cones and wood pieces grown on-site, use them as fuel, and utilize the resulting ash as fertilizer. This practice contributes to environmental sustainability and recycling efforts.
- We aim to reduce food waste by downsizing the size of pastries in our breakfast buffet.

OUR COMPOSTING PROJECT

BOKASHI COMPOST

Compost, which contributes to the recycling of organic waste, is an important practice for reducing carbon footprint and conducting waste management in an environmentally friendly manner. Composting enhances soil's natural flora, thereby increasing biological diversity. Our facility recognizes this importance and implements aerobic composting (for garden and yard waste) and anaerobic composting (for organic and food waste).



OUR COMPOSTING PROJECT

"COMPOST ANALYSIS RESULTS"

The compost application has increased the organic matter content, as well as macro and micro elements, in the soil, verified through "BATEM" analysis. Through our study, we have increased the organic matter value from 1.3 to 1.7.

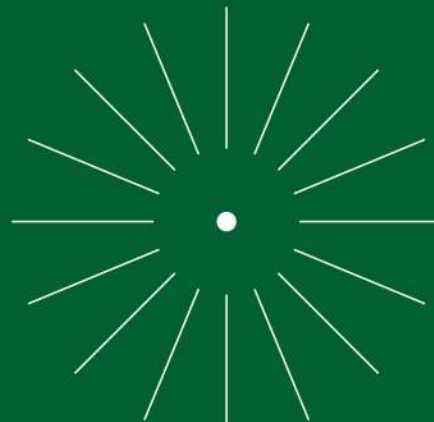
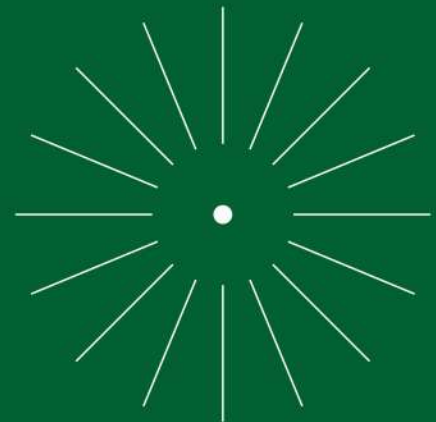

OUR ENERGY MANAGEMENT

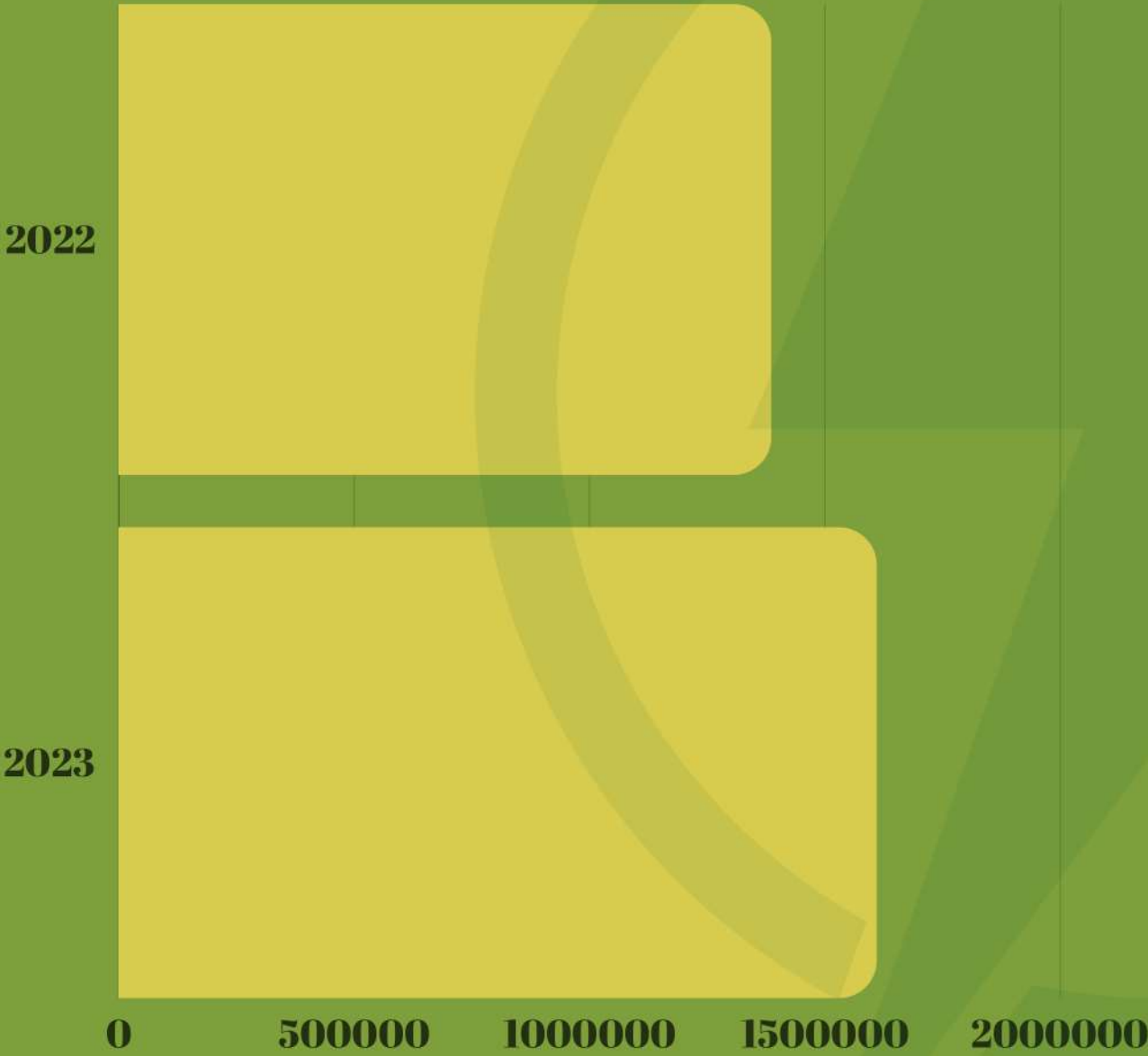
Guest room mini bars are placed to avoid direct sunlight, preventing heat build-up. A system is used to cut off electricity after guests check out. LED lighting has been implemented throughout the hotel. Sensor lights are used in public restrooms and corridors. Outdoor lighting operates on timers. In 2023, the facility aimed to reduce electricity consumption by acquiring 30 inverter air conditioners. Additionally, 5 air curtains were installed in common areas to reduce energy consumption. An installation of one heat pump has begun to save energy, and the purchase of 6 solar panels aims to save energy used for heating.



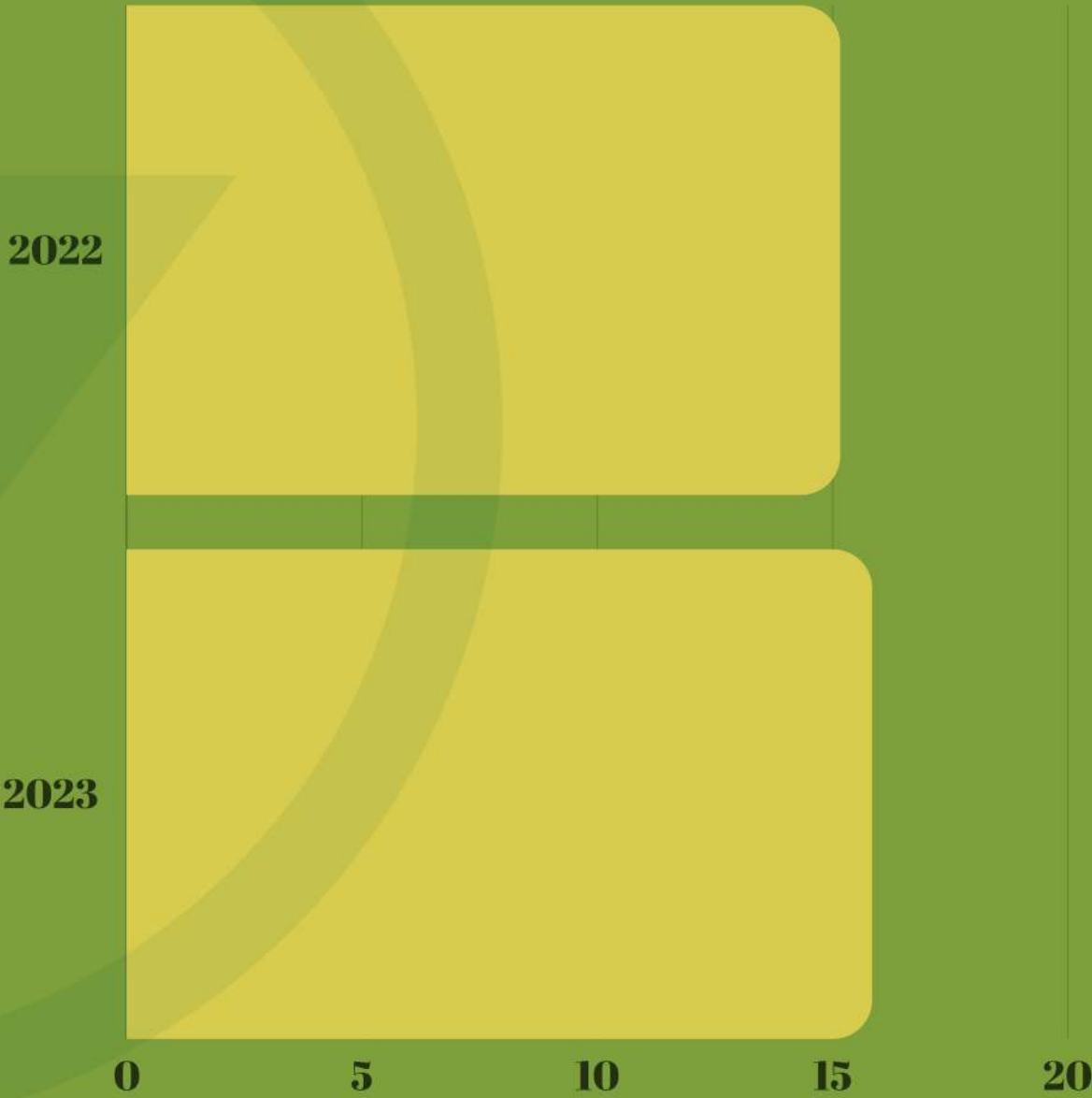

ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION KWH

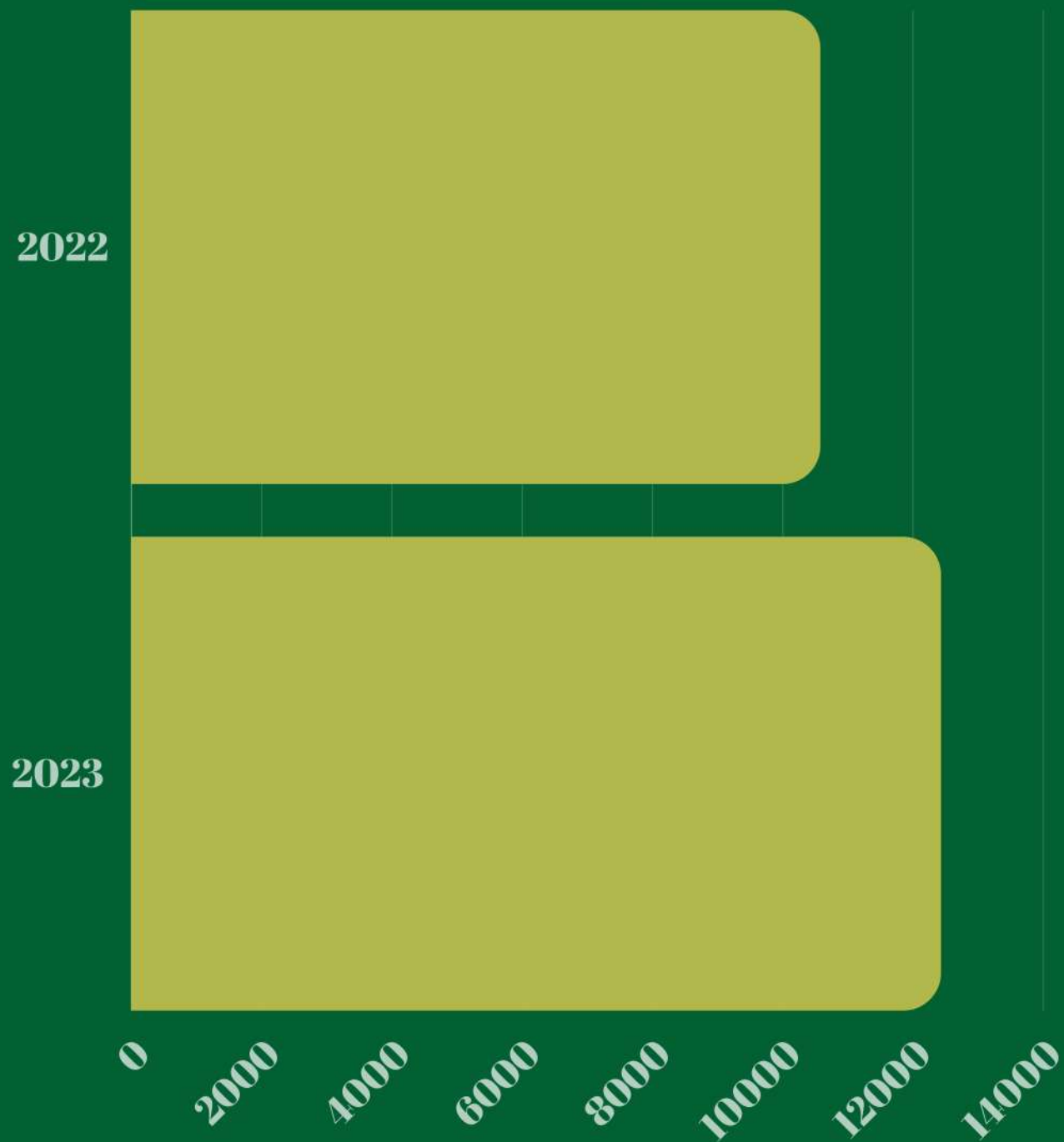


ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION PER PERSON kWh

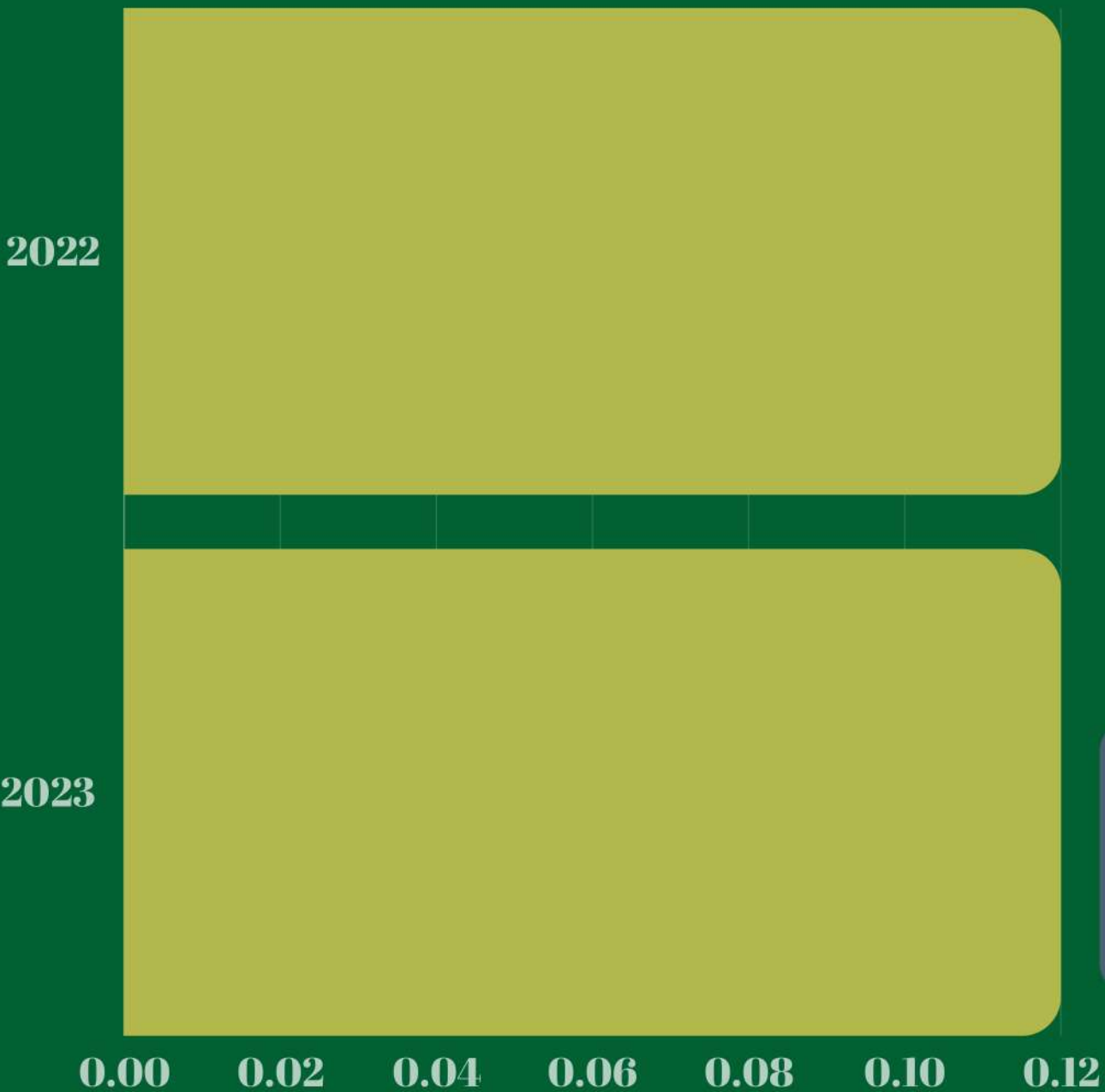

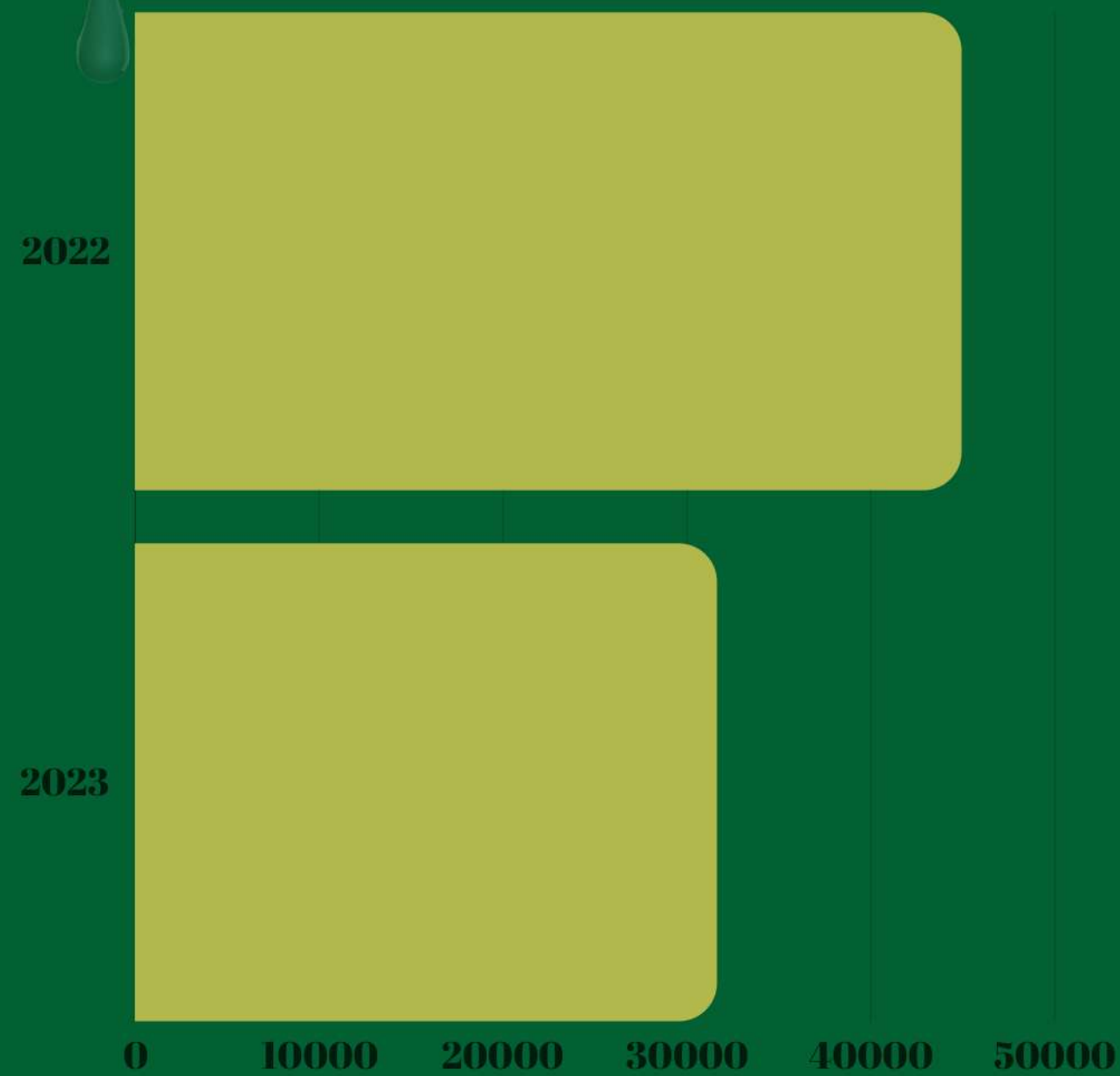
We are aware of the value of water resources. We strive to reduce water consumption. All water resources, including greywater, are disposed of in compliance with local regulations.

- We prefer landscaping plants that consume less water. Employees are educated on the importance of conserving water resources, raising awareness on this issue.
- Towel changes in rooms are carried out according to guest requests, and guests are informed about this. If there is no request from the guest, towels are changed every two days.
- Automatic flush urinals are used in public area toilets
- Garden irrigation is done with timed irrigation systems.
- We save water by using sensor batteries and sensor urinals in public areas, and knee-activated timed device batteries in production areas.
- The toilet reservoirs have been adjusted to consume 6 liters of water for water conservation purposes.
- The garden irrigation is carried out using timed irrigation systems.
- We have started using water-saving pots in the facility
- We have started using water dispensers at the facility, aiming to save water and reduce the amount of plastic bottles.

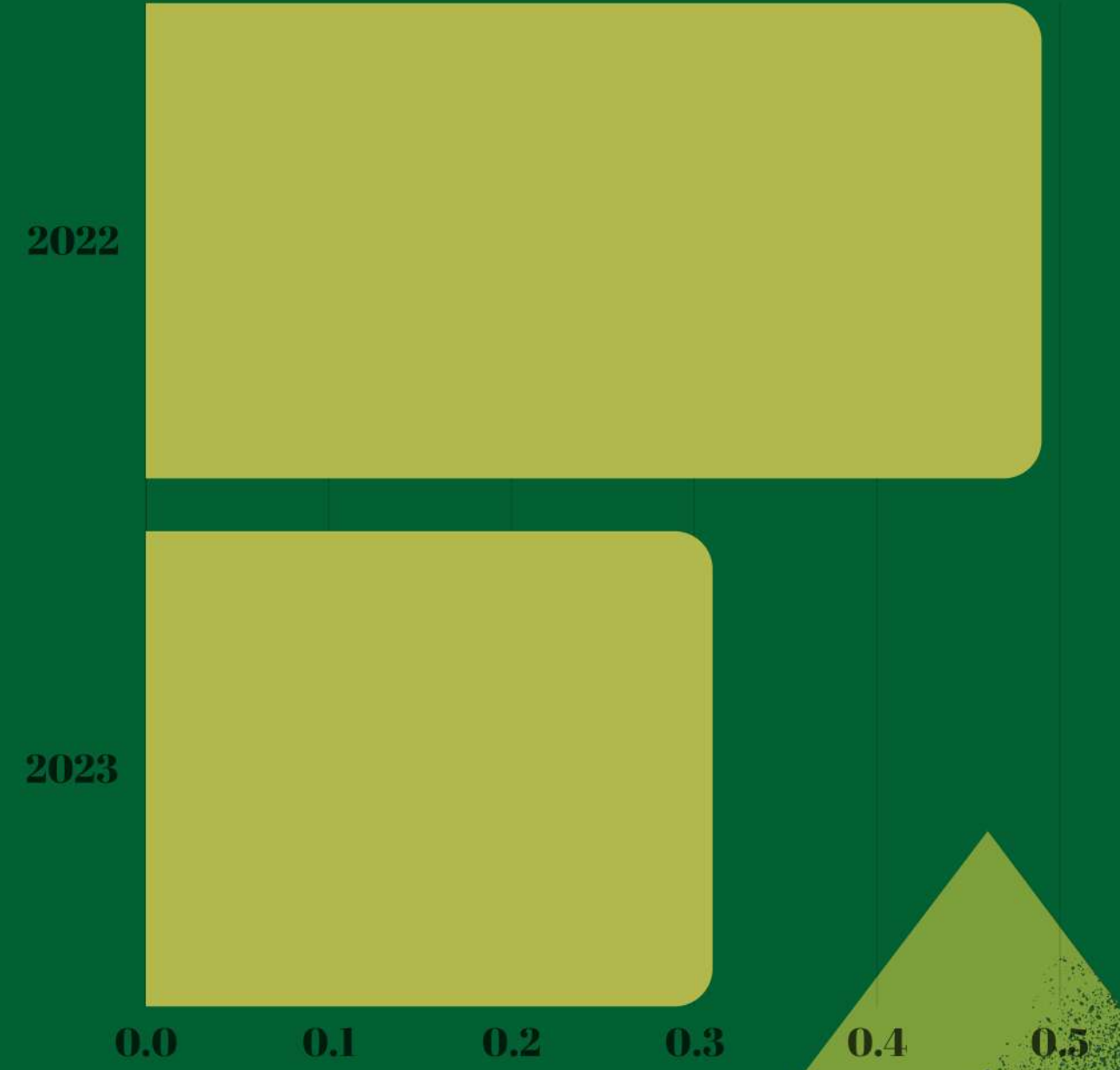


WATER SAVING

Water Consumption per Person m³

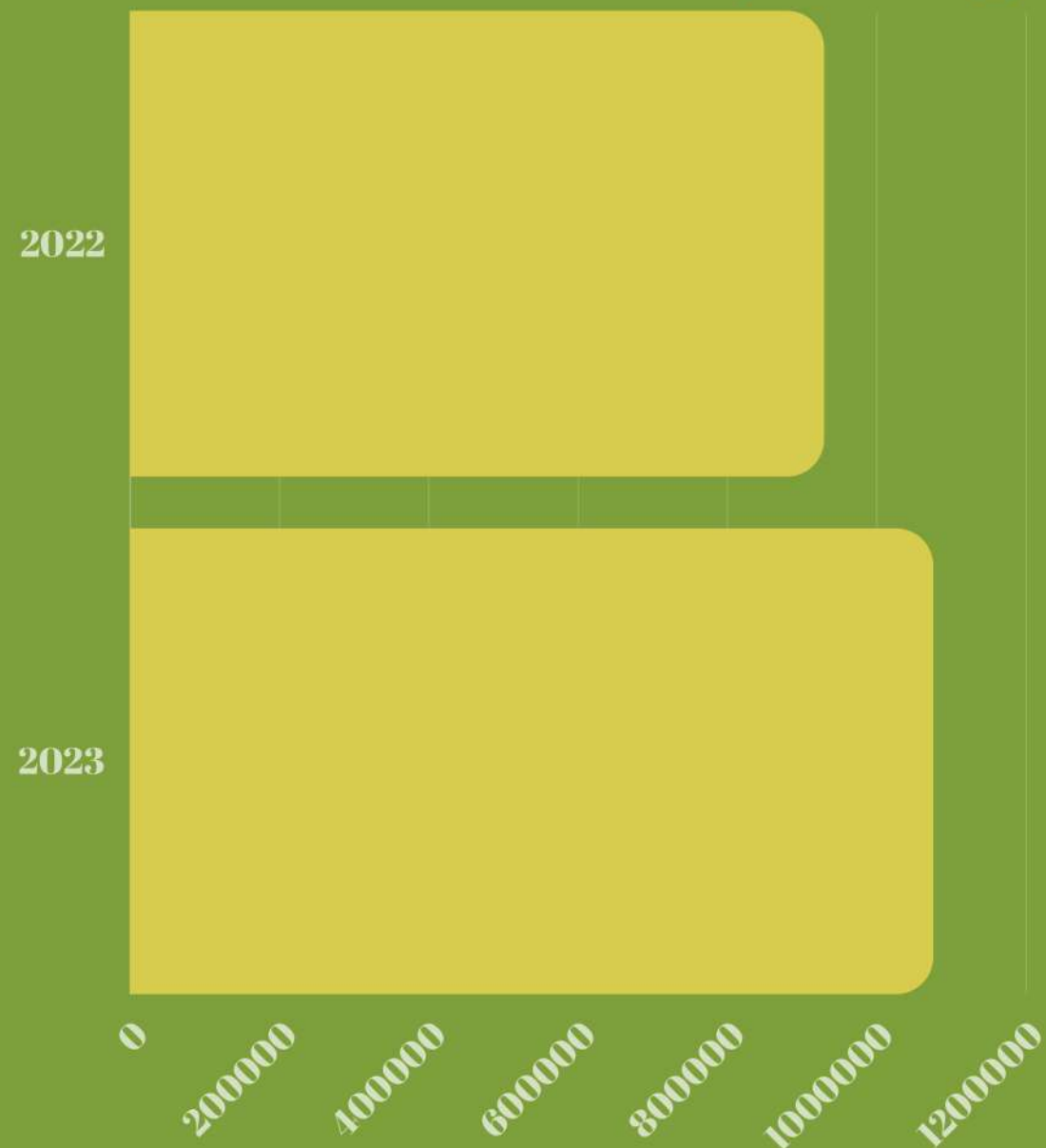

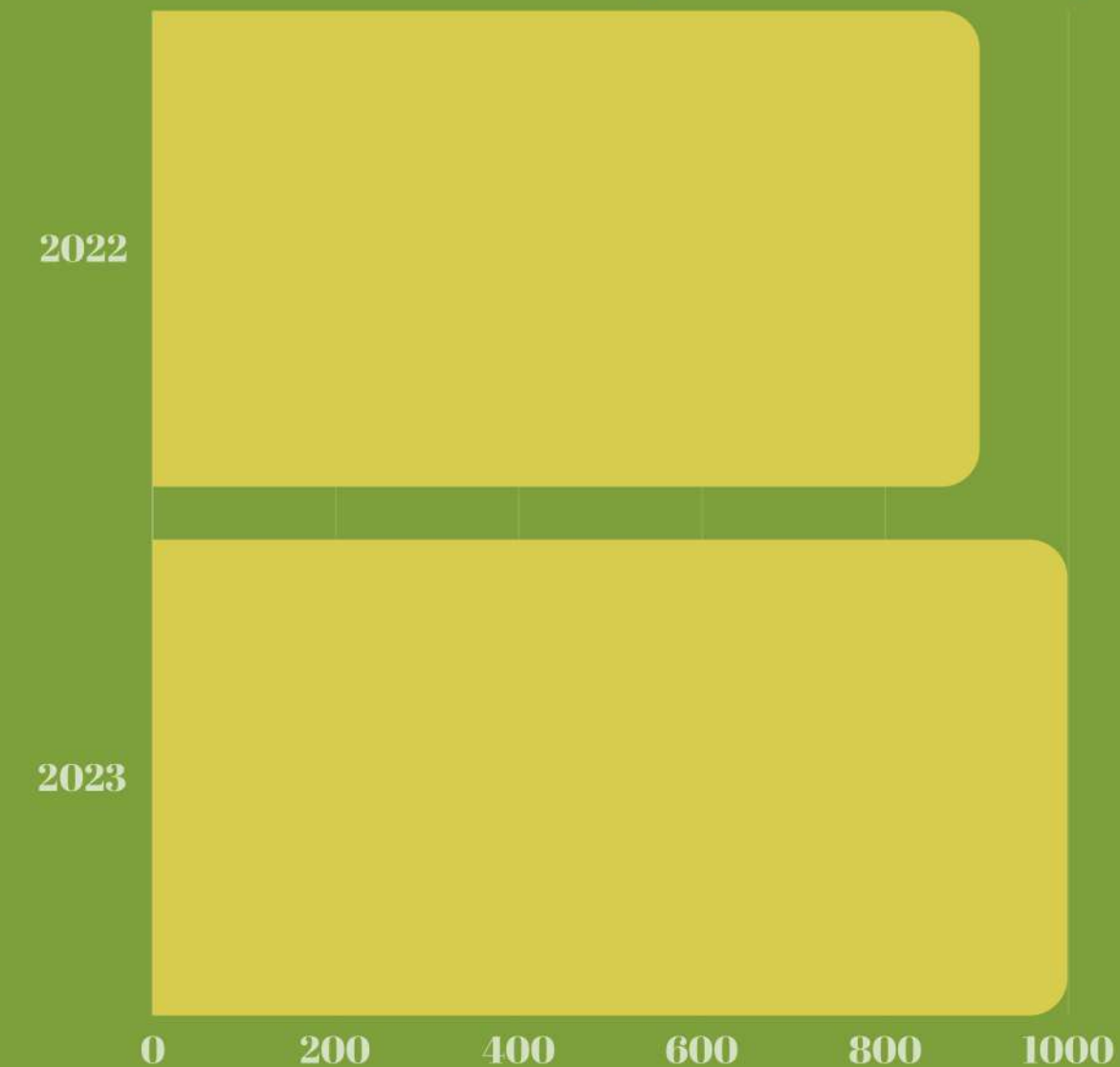
CHEMICAL CONSUMPTION

- We strive to ensure hygiene in our facility and to minimize the use of chemicals for maintenance and repair as much as possible.
- Employees who are required to use chemicals are trained properly and provided with personal protective equipment.
- Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) are placed in necessary locations, and training is provided. Necessary precautions have been taken in our warehouses against leaks, spills, and other situations that could harm the environment, and storage is done in accordance with regulations, the type of chemical, and the storage instructions of the manufacturer.
- Using the Penguin 4U device aims to reduce chemical consumption and minimize waste generation during chemical use.

RECYCLE

To support sustainability and promote a more livable environment, both our staff and guests are encouraged to contribute to recycling efforts at our facility. We have established recycling stations where they can dispose of items such as plastic caps, sunscreen containers, deodorant containers, insect repellent bottles, and used batteries, which could otherwise harm nature.

The recycling of plastics involves processing them to make them reusable again. To reduce plastic PET bottle usage, our facility has transitioned to using water dispensers in common areas.



RECYCLE

Raising awareness about unnecessary plastic usage and reducing the use of plastics and derivatives are crucial in combating plastic waste. Another measure to reduce plastic pollution is recycling. Industrial wastes need to be processed again to make them suitable for secondary use of plastic waste. Recycling plastics not only reduces plastic pollution but also saves energy.

To reduce the consumption of plastic straws, which are not recyclable in our hotel, we are gradually transitioning to using recycled paper straws.



In our hotel, we have discontinued the use of non-recyclable foam plates and instead continue to use woven baskets.

In procurement, sustainability is a priority for us. Climate conditions, which are changing globally and increasingly impacting Turkey, threaten a livable world. 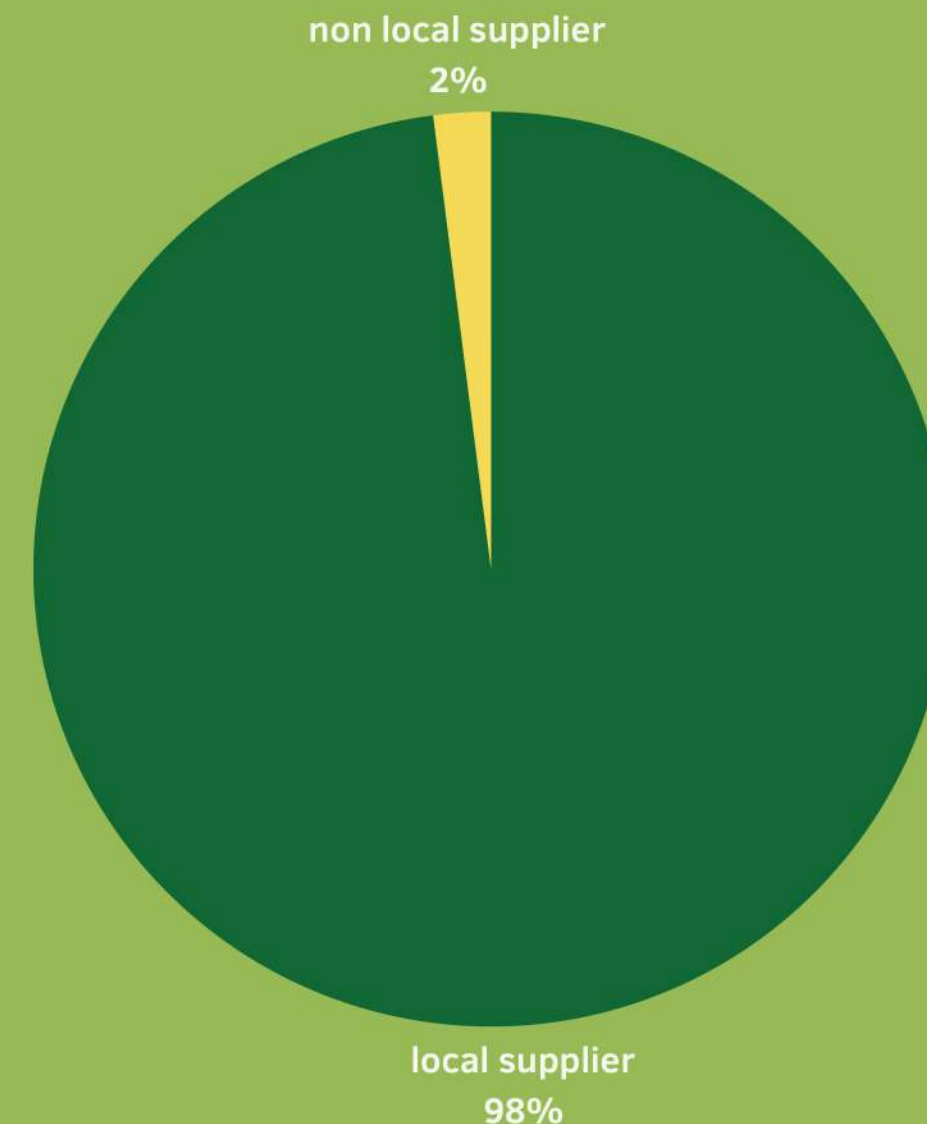

- Our approach to suppliers focuses on their Quality, Environmental, and Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems, as well as their adherence to environmental regulations and sustainability certifications. We emphasize the importance of periodic audits to ensure compliance.
- We prioritize suppliers who have environmental and sustainability certifications and ensure they use natural resources without harming ecosystems. Specifically for products like wood, paper, fish, and other food items sourced from the wild, we prefer suppliers and products that are environmentally certified.
- In our facilities, we carefully manage the procurement and use of consumables, including food, to minimize waste. We prefer reusable, returnable, and recycled products to reduce waste generation.

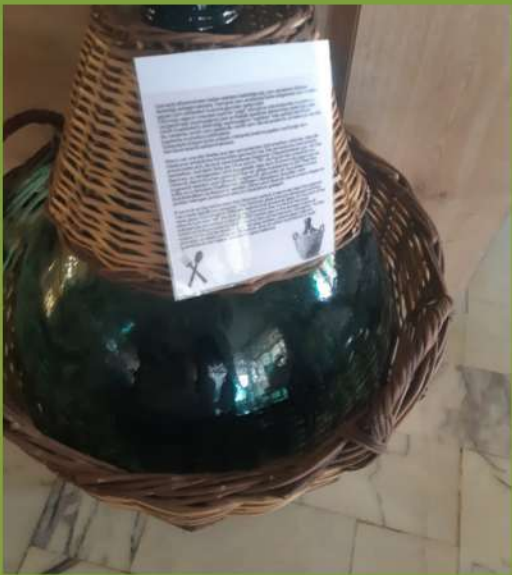

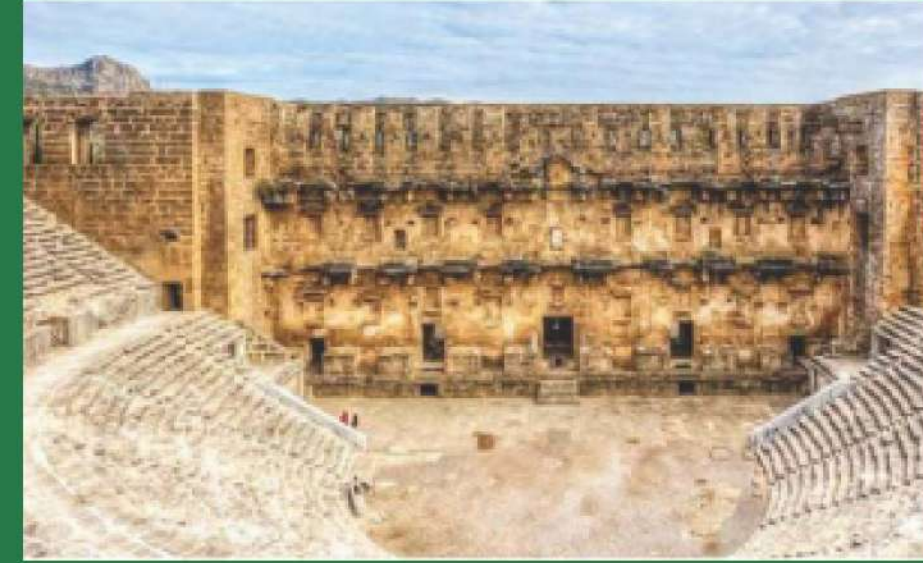

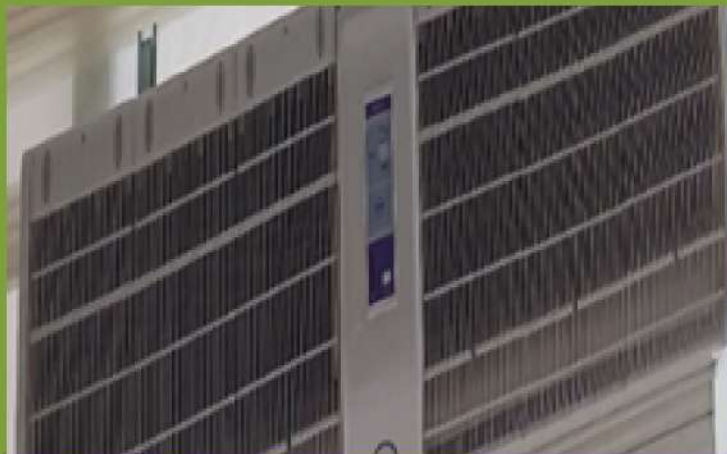

CARBON FOOTPRINT

Our developing world is experiencing increased energy and food production alongside population growth, resulting in by-products and waste. To assess the impact of these wastes on our planet, the concept of carbon footprint has emerged. The carbon footprint consists of two components: primary and secondary.
